The sole surviving adult child of the decedent whose whereabouts is reasonably ascertained or if there is more than one adult child the decedent, the majority of the surviving adult children whose whereabouts are reasonably ascertained; 5. The surviving parent or parents of the decedent, whose whereabouts are reasonably ascertained; 6. The surviving adult brother or sister of the decedent whose whereabouts is reasonably ascertained; 7. The guardian of the person of the decedent at the time of the death of the decedent, if one had been appointed; 8. The person in the classes of the next degree of kinship, in descending order, under the laws of descent and distribution to inherit estate of the decedent. If there is more than one person of the same degree, any person of that degree may exercise the right disposition;
